REQUIREMENTS



YOU AND YOUR PARENTS MUST BE U.S. CITIZENS OR PERMANENT RESIDENTS OF MICHIGAN AS OF THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR.

FILE A FAFSA FOR EACH YEAR OF STUDY.

EARN AT LEAST 10 CREDIT HOURS EACH YEAR.

MAINTAIN A 3.0 CUMULATIVE GPA OR ABOVE.

REMAIN ENROLLED FULL-TIME.

COMMITMENT TO TEACH AGREEMENT

Each year you are required to apply for the fellowship and sign an agreement to teach at a MICHIGAN PUBLIC school.

4 YEARS COMMITMENT TO TEACH

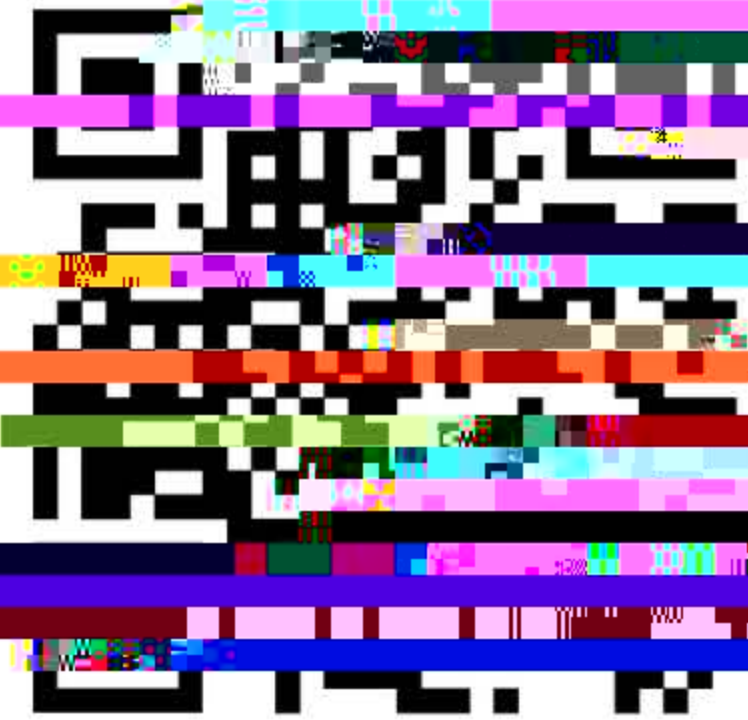

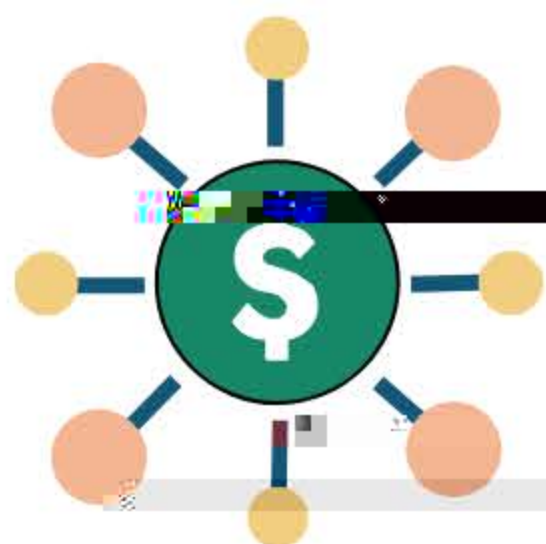

FUNDS



IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR A STUDENT LOAN WITH A DEFERRMENT TERM OF 10 YEARS.

YOU MAY ALSO QUALIFY FOR THE \$25,000 STUDENT TEACHING FELLOWSHIP. NOT FILL OUT THAT APPLICATION UNTIL YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE FELLOWSHIP FUNDS.
